Treatment:

- Keep the casualty at rest, reassured, and under constant observation
- Call 000 or 112
- Follow the basic life support guidelines per DRSABCD
- Apply the *Pressure Immobilisation Technique* by tightly wrapping a wide elastic bandage over the bite site and all the way up the limb
- Apply a second elastic bandage as far up the limb as possible and make sure to mark the bite site with a pen or texta
- Immobilise the limb with a sling (arm) or splint (leg)

Treatment:

- Reassure the casualty and keep them under constant observation
- Apply a cold compress to the bite site for periods of up to 20 minutes
- If the casualty is a young child (under 8 years of age), a pregnant woman, or exhibit any signs of deterioration, follow DRSABCD and call 000
- Do NOT use the *Pressure Immobilisation Technique*, as this will just worsen the pain
